

Benefits of Each Membership

Full Memberships:

All Full Memberships provide the Individual or Family access to golf course, driving range, pool, and clubhouse. Discounted rental of clubhouse and pool facilities. Other fees apply for cart rental, driving range balls, and guests. Non-Resident Memberships are for individuals or families that are not living in or own a business in Harrison County.

Transition and Student Memberships:

Transition and Student Memberships provide Individual access to golf course, driving range, pool, and clubhouse. Other fees apply for cart rental, driving range balls, and guests. There is no partial year membership or application promotion. These do not provide discounted rental of clubhouse and pool facilities. Student Membership only: Cart rental fees are \$5 per 9 holes and receives 1/2 locker. All other fees are the same.

Pool Membership (formerly Limited Membership):

The Pool Membership provides the Individual or Family access to pool, and clubhouse. Discounted rental of clubhouse and pool facilities. Other fees apply for guests.

Social Membership:

The Social Membership provides the Individual or Family access to clubhouse. This membership does not provide discounted rental of clubhouse.

Requirements for Classification of Each Membership

Full Memberships:

Full Membership – Married, Single with Dependents, or Single. Eldest or only individual is 30-64 as of Jan 1 of the membership (calendar) year. Stock purchase required, if not already owned. **Note:** The “Full Membership” and “Full Membership Single” have the same age requirements, but the “Single” has a reduced dues rate and is listed separately on other membership documents.

Full Membership Senior – Married, Single with Dependents, or Single. Eldest or only individual is 65 years old or older as of Jan 1 of the membership (calendar) year. Stock purchase required, if not already owned.

Full Membership Junior – Married, Single with Dependents, or Single. If married or single with dependents, the eldest individual has graduated high school through 29 years old as of Jan 1 of the membership (calendar) year. If single, the individual is 24-29 years old as of Jan 1 of the membership (calendar) year. Stock purchase is optional.

Full Membership Non-Resident – Married, Single with Dependents, or Single. Applies only to individuals who do not reside or have a business in Harrison County. If married or single with dependents, the eldest individual has graduated high school through any age as of Jan 1 of the membership (calendar) year. If single, the individual is 24 years old or older as of Jan 1 of the membership (calendar) year. **Note:** A non-resident can also qualify under the Student or Transition Membership if they meet the criteria. Stock purchase required, if not already owned.

Transition Membership – Single and the individual has graduated high school through age 23 as of Jan 1 of the membership (calendar) year. Stock purchase is optional.

Student Membership – Single and the individual is in the 6th-12th grades as of Jan 1 of the membership (calendar) year. Participation in Youth on Course Program which includes taking the online course and submitting your played rounds. Stock purchase not permitted.

Pool Membership (formerly Limited Membership):

Pool Membership – Married, single with dependents, or single. The eldest or only graduated high school through any age as of Jan 1 of the membership (calendar) year. **Note:** If single without dependents and the individual is between the 6th grade and 23 years old as of Jan 1 of the membership (calendar) year, the individual meets the requirements to classify for the Student or Transition Memberships. With those memberships the individual would have less dues and gain access to the golf course and driving range. Give golf a try.

Social Membership:

Social Membership – Married, single with dependents, or single and individual is between the 6th grade through any age as of Jan 1 of the membership (calendar) year. **Note:** If single and the individual is between the 6th-12th grades as of Jan 1 of the membership (calendar) year, the individual meets the requirements to classify for the Student Membership. With that membership the individual would have less dues and gain access to the golf course, driving range, and pool. Give golf a try.

Family Members and Dependents

A man and a woman (couple), their unmarried children less than 21 years of age, and their unmarried children of any age as long as such children are students regularly attending school or college and living in the same household as the parents.

The eldest member's age is the determining factor for membership classification. If there is only one member, then the determining factor is that individual's age.

In the event of death or divorce during shared membership, the Club will not change the status of either party until the end of the membership (calendar which is also the club's fiscal) year (December 31).
